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Training KIT

The Dali4Youth project aims to prepare youth workers and young people, particularly NEETs, to meet the current needs of the youth sector following the COVID-19 pandemic, such as a sense of belonging to our society, more and improved digital skills, a higher level of creativity to adapt to the new reality, and greater awareness of the situation NEETs are in.

The project will use digital technologies with a creative and artistic perspective to promote social inclusion, which should be prioritised by any person, entity, or institution involved in youth work. To that end, the project has created an online Training KIT focusing on digital art and aimed at youth workers.

Piloting

The Online Training KIT will provide youth workers with the theoretical knowledge needed to work with NEETs as well as strategies, techniques, and resources necessary to adapt the knowledge to their educational contexts.

Each partner organisation conducted a pilot test to ensure the quality of the online training course. This pilot test will conclude with an in-depth evaluation of the modules by the participants via an online questionnaire. After which they will be analysed, and a sheet of modifications and final recommendations will be created to improve the project's first tangible result.
