Thus, this Erasmus+ project came response to this events' turnover. It aims at preparing academics of Higher Education Institutes (HEI) to better develop and deliver their online courses, enhance learning outcomes and keep students interested and involved.




In Poland, Warsaw University of Life Sciences organized the Multiplier Event for March 31st. Here is a picture of the partecipants.
